



Sport and Recreation Career Pathways Program Student Futures

The Sport and Recreation Career Pathways Program Student Futures package provides current students in Western Australia with networking and professional development opportunities to further enhance their ability to become a quality part of the workforce.

Offered to six WA students enrolled in an eligible sport and recreation-related course between June to December 2011, the program provides selected participants with:

- Attendance at a specialised industry networking event with representatives from sport and recreation organisations.
- Three professional development workshops on varying topics.
- Assistance to complete training courses or workshops specific to individual development needs.
- An official certificate of recognition.

The following will be required of participants throughout the program:

- Attendance at all organised events and workshops.
- Completion of an individual volunteer project of at least 20 hours over the June to December program period.
- Completion of a log book regarding the individual volunteer project.

Applications close 4pm on 20 May 2011. Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application in June 2011. The program will commence in July 2011.
